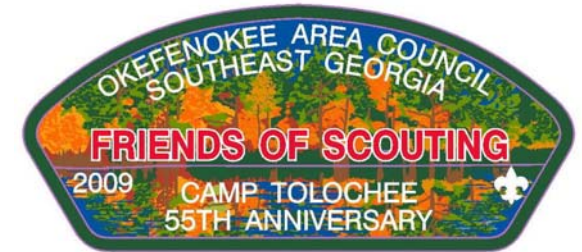

The council has over 3,500 youth members in Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venturing, Exploring and Learning for Life programs.



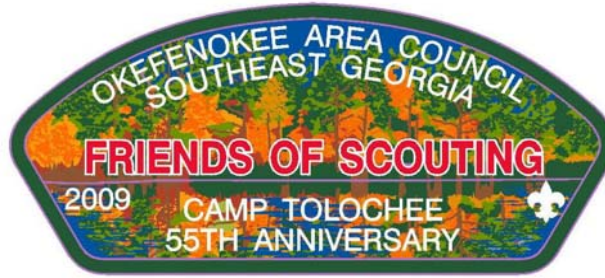
We have Cub Scout Packs, Boy Scout Troops, Venture Crews, Explorer Posts throughout all the 10 counties we serve.
