



## Pilthlako Lodge 229 Brotherhood Membership Application

When you have continued faithfully to serve your fellowman and have completed the following requirements, you may then seal your membership in the Order through the Brotherhood Ceremony.

This form allows the Chapter Chief and Adviser to verify your completion of the Brotherhood requirements before you attend the Brotherhood ceremony. Brotherhood Questioning will not longer be done at the fellowship, this has been passed down to the chapters. At the fellowship you will have a Brotherhood experience then followed by the ceremony!

### Brotherhood Requirements:

- Have had 10 months of service as an Ordeal Member
- Registered active membership in Scouting
- Registered active membership in the Order of the Arrow
- Memorize the Obligation, the Order of the Arrow Official Song, and the Admonition.

It is important that you not only meet the above requirements but that you feel you are prepared for the Brotherhood. Write a letter to the Lodge secretary expressing your feeling. In you letter:

- Explain what you thank the obligation means.
- Describe how you have been fulfilling this Obligation in your Troop or Team and in your daily life, and how you have used your understanding of the traditions of the Ordeal to aid in your service.
- Describe the specific plans you have for rendering service to the lodge in fulfillment of the new pledge you expect to take,

With this letter you should include this form, signed by the Chapter Chief and Adviser, and your advance Brotherhood registration fee of \$15.00. This does not include the fellowship registration fees. Brotherhood Ceremonies are held during the March and November Fellowships.
